It's Election Time!



Every other year, we ask that our chapters conduct elections for chapter leaders. Elections are held in odd-numbered

years, with terms beginning on January 1 of even-numbered years. Officers are elected for a two-year term. So sometime this fall, your chapter should conduct its election of chapter leaders who will begin their two-year term on January 1, 2020. The election can take place at your fall dinner, member celebration, or another event, so long as participation in the vote is limited to eligible members of your chapter.

Members should be notified in advance that an election is taking place, to provide them with the opportunity to vote and/or to be considered for a chapter officer position. The best way to reach the members of your chapter is by using our free chapter invitation service. The quickest way to submit your invitation request is online, using our Fraternal Data System.

Please remember that the Fraternal Data System requires a separate log-in from "My Account" on our new website.

Updating your officer list online can be accomplished using the FDS as well! It takes only a matter of minutes. For those continuing on in their current positions, simply update the date of the "Last Election." For those ending their terms, enter the "End Date" and "End Reason." For brand new officers, or those elected to a different position for 2020, select "Add" and then enter the required information. The start date should be 01/01/2020. Contact the Member Engagement Department if you have any questions.
